1. Introduction

Nummularius (“**Nummularius**,” “**we**,” “**us**,” or “**our**”) operates a cryptocurrency exchange platform that enables users to trade digital tokens backed by earth minerals. We are committed to protecting your privacy, safeguarding your personal data, and maintaining transparency regarding how your information is collected, used, stored, and disclosed.

This Privacy Policy explains our practices regarding personal information when you access or use the Nummularius website, mobile applications, APIs, wallets, and related services (collectively, the “**Platform**”).

2. Tokens Offered on the Platform

Nummularius supports the trading of the following asset-backed digital tokens:

- **Nummu Gold (NGT)**
Trading price guidance is linked to the **COMEX Gold market price**.
- **Nummu Oil (NOT)**
Trading price guidance is linked to the **West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude oil market price**.
- **Nummu Cell (NCT)**
Trading price guidance is linked to **spot market prices of Lithium Carbonate**.

Price guidance does not guarantee price parity and is subject to market dynamics, liquidity, and platform conditions.

3. Information We Collect

3.1 Personal Information You Provide

We may collect the following information when you register or use the Platform:

- Full legal name
- Date of birth
- Nationality and country of residence
- Email address and phone number
- Government-issued identification (passport, driver's license, national ID)
- Proof of address (utility bill, bank statement, or similar)
- Selfie or biometric verification (where required)
- Wallet addresses and transaction identifiers

3.2 Automatically Collected Information

When you access the Platform, we may automatically collect:

- IP address
- Device identifiers
- Browser type and operating system
- Log files and access times
- Usage patterns and interaction data

3.3 Financial & Transaction Data

- Token balances and transaction history
- Deposit and withdrawal records
- Blockchain transaction hashes
- Linked payment or custody provider identifiers (where applicable)

4. Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal data based on one or more of the following legal grounds:

- Performance of a contract
- Compliance with legal obligations (e.g., KYC/AML laws)
- Legitimate business interests

- User consent (where applicable)

5. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Create and manage user accounts
 - Verify identity and comply with KYC/AML regulations
 - Enable trading, transfers, and custody of tokens
 - Process deposits and withdrawals
 - Monitor transactions for fraud, abuse, or illegal activity
 - Improve platform performance and user experience
 - Communicate service updates, security alerts, and regulatory notices

6. Know Your Customer (KYC) & Anti-Money Laundering (AML)

To comply with applicable financial regulations, Nummularius conducts identity verification and ongoing monitoring. This may include:

- Identity checks through third-party verification providers
- Sanctions and watchlist screening
- Transaction monitoring and reporting to regulatory authorities when required by law

Failure to provide required verification may result in restricted or suspended access to the Platform.

7. Cookies & Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

8. Data Sharing & Disclosure

We may share your information with:
